

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FY23 Enrollment Context









- Total enrollment has declined roughly 7,100 students in 5 years.
- K0 5 enrollment has declined roughly 4,800 students in 5 years.
- Assuming median elementary school size of 288 students, that's the equivalent of about 17 schools worth of K0 5 students.




We anticipate enrollment declines for FY23





K2 Enrollment and Birth Rates Are Declining and Will Likely Continue to Decline

- Births to Boston Residents have dropped by over 600 since 2011
- This is consistent with the national trend of declining birth rates




- Largest indicator of future enrollment is current enrollment
- As K2 5 enrollment has declined by nearly 5,000 students in 5 years, we expect those smaller cohorts to lead to smaller enrollment in grades 6 12 as current students age

Elementary Enrollment Declines Predict Future Middle and High School Declines

Over the last 5 years:

- Total K0-12 enrollment has declined by 7,100 students (blue line)
- The number of students in grades K2 to 11 leaving the system (red line) has stayed
- relatively stable
 The number of students new to BPS in grades K2 to 11 (yellow line) has declined by 2,237 students, or 32%

The declines are a function of fewer new students, not of more students exiting the system

English Learner Enrollment




The total number of English Learners increased slightly this year but is still down 14% compared to 3 years ago

Enrollment in English Learner programs declined 5% this year and is down 19% compared to 3 years ago


- SEI Enrollment is down across all language groups
- Enrollment in low-incidence, language specific SLIFE has declined
- Spanish SLIFE enrollment is up nearly 50% this year, which is connected to an increase in the proportion of ELs identified as requiring SLIFE programs

The number of ELs with disabilities has not decreased at the same rate as ELs in general, which is consistent with broader district trends

English Learners with Disabilities

Implications for Projections

Future year projections are primarily driven by the number of students currently enrolled

- BPS tends to lose students as they age except in entry grades (K2, 7, 9)
- A small K2 cohort does not typically grow as it progresses through BPS
- Enrollment news from our key grades is not promising
 - K2 enrollment is down
 - 7th and 9th grade growth is down

Even with a rebound in K2, 7th and 9th grade next year, low enrollment in these cohorts of students are likely to persist
