








## OEL Summer Learning (Rising K-12)

- OEL offers programs focused on grade-level academic skills in Math and ESL/ELA to improve the English language acquisition of English Learner students.
- July 6 August 6, 2021
- Eligibility: English Learner Students in Grades K-12 with priority given to compensatory students, SLIFE and ELD 1-3s.
- Budget:~\$2,582,172
- Projected Number of Seats: 2500
