# What does equity look like for ELs in a remote learning environment?

ESL instruction is a **core** content area for English Learners and therefore must be reflected in the school's master remote schedule. The ESL blocks should be proportional to their regular schedule in Aspen. Consider organizing your schedule as follows:

ELD	Times
1	1 hr per day (at least 30 mins)
2	45 mins per day (at least 30 mins)
3	25 mins per day
4-5	Continue to embed ESL within ELA from ESL licensed teacher
All	Access to ESL and content teachers' office hours for support

### **ACCESS & ELD Levels**

OEL **will automatically assign ELD levels** during the end of year SY1920 in alignment with <u>DESE guidelines</u>. School-based LATFs may propose an alternate ELD level to OEL for approval based on WIDA-aligned evidence of student work.

2020 ACCESS Composite Level Range (refer to <u>DESE Guidance</u> )	ELD Level OEL will Assign
ACCESS: <b>1.0 - 1.7</b> ACCESS Alt: <b>A1-P1</b>	ELD1
ACCESS: <b>1.8 - 2.4</b> ACCESS Alt: <b>P2</b>	ELD 2
ACCESS: <b>2.5 - 3.4</b> ACCESS Alt: <b>P3</b>	ELD 3
ACCESS: <b>3.5 - 4.1</b>	ELD 4
ACCESS: <b>4.2 or higher</b>	ELD 5
ACCESS: Met exit criteria to be FEL	FEL
