

# Rubric for Children's Dioramas and Presentations

Score

<b>3</b>	<p><b>CAPABLE</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The diorama is original, three-dimensional, and well detailed. Colors are often used effectively and appropriately to show the subject and the setting.</li> <li>• The background drawings and stand-up figures convey several important details about the subject and the setting. Small details may require the child's explanation.</li> </ul>
<b>2</b>	<p><b>DEVELOPING</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The diorama consists mainly of a single-background drawing drawn or pasted inside the box to show the setting. One or two stand-up figures may be affixed to the base of the box. Colors are sometimes used appropriately.</li> <li>• The diorama displays some relevant details about the subject and the setting.</li> </ul>
<b>1</b>	<p><b>NOVICE</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The diorama has a drawing (for example, trees and sky) that includes few or no relevant details about the subject, or the drawing is incomplete. Colors are seldom used appropriately.</li> <li>• The diorama displays few or no relevant or important details about the subject or the setting.</li> </ul>

## Presentations

<b>3</b>	The oral presentation indicates a very good understanding of the subject and the elements in the setting.
<b>2</b>	The oral presentation indicates a satisfactory understanding of the subject and the elements in the setting.
<b>1</b>	The oral presentation provides few facts about the subject and the elements in the setting.
